General Description

This course applies and develops the rhythmic, melodic, and harmonic materials of Music Theory IV through ear training, sight singing, analysis, and dictation.

Content

This course resides in a sequence, and elements of this course may appear in another course within the sequence.

Minimum topics:

1. Melodic and Harmonic:
 - a. Advanced chromaticism, including
 1. modulations to distantly-related keys
 2. mode mixture
 3. non-dominant 7th chords
 4. Neapolitan and augmented 6th chords
 5. extended and altered chords
 6. diatonic modes
 7. non-diatonic and synthetic scales: whole-tone, pentatonic, octatonic
 - b. Post-tonal materials, including pitch sets, tone rows, and post-tonal melodies
2. Advanced rhythmic topics, including
 - i. irregular beat divisions
 - ii. polyrhythms
 - iii. asymmetrical and mixed meters

Additional activities

- Perform and sight-read rhythmic exercises in two and three parts
- Perform single line rhythm and sight-singing exercises while conducting
- Detect errors in rhythm, pitch, and/or solfege
- Perform exercises in one or more parts (canons, duets, chorales, sing and play the piano, sing and clap rhythms, etc.)
